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Notes on how to take clear finger-prints
<u>A BLURRED FINGER-PRINT HAS NO VALUE . ALL PRINTS MUST BE AS CLEAR AS POSSIBLE</u>
(a) ALWAYS enter particulars of person on finger-print form IMMEDIATELY AFTER taking his finger-prints. DO NOT take other prints until you have done so.
(b) ALWAYS use the correct ink supplied. DO NOT use ordinary ink or the ink on an inking pad for rubber stamps.
(c) Fingers must be clean and dry. If necessary, person having prints taken must wash hands.
(d) If fingers are badly worn, make smooth by using pumice stone. Remove oil or tar with benzine.
(e) Use a clean pad with no dust or old ink on it. Put ink on evenly - no lumps or blobs. Do not use too much ink (this is a common fault).

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
